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#### 1. WHO TO INCLUDE IN



- All persons who have their main residence at this address on May 10, 2011, including newborn babies, room-mates, boarders, foster children, persons who are temporarily away, and all other related and unrelated persons living here;
- Canadian citizens, permanent residents (landed immigrants), persons asking
  for refugee status (refugee claimants), persons from another country with a work
  or study permit and family members living here with them;
- Persons staying at this address temporarily on May 10, 2011 who have no main residence elsewhere.

## 2. WHERE TO INCLUDE PERSONS WITH MORE THAN ONE RESIDENCE

- CHILDREN IN JOINT CUSTODY should be included in the hone of the parent where they live most of the time. Children who spend equal time with each parent should be included in the home of the parent with whom they are saming on May 10, 2011.
- **STUDENTS** who return to live with their parant, during to year should be included at their parents' address, even if they live elsewhe. While attending school or working at a summer job.
- SPOUSES OR COMMON-LAW PARTNERS TO PORARILY AWAY who stay elsewhere



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


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
