The Find Tool:

Search for:

1. City or place.
2. Locate an address.

The Report Tool:

To make a report, click on this button and a dialog will appear.

Only three steps are required to make a custom area report:

1. Choose a selection method from the dialog.
2. Select an area using the mouse. All selections, except the circle, require a dbl-click to end selection.
3. Choose the report you would like to produce for the selected area.
4. Once produced the report will print or can be downloaded to Excel

- Pan:** Drag the map to
position.

Print Button:
Brings up a new browser
window and loads a map
with a legend that's better
formatted for printing.
